Boy and Girl Scout participation; church, Bible School and summer camp counselors; blood donors or blood drive volunteers; participant in a community park and roads clean-up day; volunteer at a food bank or community re-sale shop; youth sports coach or assistant; participant in church, synagogue, or temple mission trips; after school program volunteer; student tutor; participant in charity fun runs, walks, or other fund raising activities.

All activities supporting the application are to be outside of school. Other activities not listed above will be considered

Application Process: The applicant must write an essay on what community service means to them, the importance of giving back to their community, and how they have contributed. Participation in each activity or event must be verified in writing by an adult sponsor.
